Prof. Walter Schmidt is employed as a lecturer at the Faculty of Family Studies at UKSW where he manages the Centre for Research on Work and Family Balance. Prof. Schmidt obtained a PhD in economy at the University of Vienna and a PhD in philosophy at the University of Eichstätt-Ingolstadt. He published the book "Rush Hour

of life", in which he introduced ways to solve current conflicts between professional and family life. Prof. Schmidt carries out research on the development of management staff. For many years, he was holding top manager positions in marketing and sales in well-known international companies. In 1987 he started InterMedia, an international company which deals with personal counseling in management and executive search. In 1993 he co-founded SearchNet International, a global network of executive search companies. Prof. Schmidt is also actively engaged in the work of many entrepreneurial organizations and social institutions. He gives lectures in education, training and designing life-careers of female and male managers.
